

Adding a Screensaver


The adding of a screensaver is done through the Admin back office.




Upload image to Admin and use on kiosk.

To upload an image follow these few steps. This is the picture that you will have as your screensaver.

Navigate to Network > Media Upload



Under the select media type tab select Background Image / Logo, then under Media name write the name you want for the image. Click the Browse button and select the image required and click Upload (make sure that the image is PNG).



When the image is uploaded go to: *Network > Settings > Kiosk Settings*Then go to Kiosk/Location tab and then search for the kiosk in question. And then in the key field search for the values:

StartPageImage, for changing the start page image, add the name of the startpage image you just uploaded with the extension .png at the end and then: **ShowStartPageOverlay,** write True in the value field.

Localizations:

There is a default text saying "Hi! Tap to enter." when adding a screensaver if you don't want this to show on your kiosk you can easily remove those two localizations in admin, just remove the text and write a space and then click next to the field and it should be green which means it saved. Note that there can be only one localization override per key word in each database so either by operator or store name etc.

Look for these localizations:

start_page_hi & start_page_tap_to_enter



Update/sync:

The changes will be updated automatically after some time but if you need the change immediately follow these steps:

Sync the settings and the files on the kiosk (on the sync page). Then just restart the kioskware through the merchandiser view.
